Pinnacle Community Services assists individuals with their Activities of Daily Living

Activities of daily living (ADL) are routine activities that people do every day. There are six basic ADLs: eating, bathing, dressing, toileting, transferring (walking) and continence. Pinnacle supports independent living by helping individuals with activities such as going shopping, reminding them to take medications and accompanying them on walks. Pinnacle provides an option for individuals who have a developmental disability that may not be able to bathe, get dressed, use the toilet, eat, take their medicine or perform other essential tasks without help.
